NOTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY
OF
ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN

June 7, 2013

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) required the compilation of all asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM) within the public and private schools (K-12 grades). A building inspection by EPA-accredited asbestos inspectors was conducted to determine, not only if asbestos was in our schools, but its condition. After the inspection, a plan to manage the identified asbestos was developed.

AHERA further required that the identified asbestos-containing materials were to be checked every six months by the trained school personnel and that these materials were to be re-inspected by an accredited inspector every three years as long as the materials remain in the buildings.

The North Putnam Community School Corporation has complied with the AHERA by developing and implementing an Asbestos Management Plan for its school facilities. All identified asbestos material are being monitored and maintained in good condition by trained school personnel. The three year inspections have been completed as required and have been added to the Management Plan.

Anyone wishing to view a copy of the Management Plan for an individual school building will find it available in the principal's office. The Management Plan for all of the schools in the school corporation is available for your viewing in the Transportation/Maintenance office.

If you have any questions concerning the AHERA program, please contact your building principal and/or the designated person, Mr. Arnold Caldwell.

The Asbestos Management Plan will be updated annually as response actions are completed or as periodic surveillance reveals a change in the condition of the asbestos materials.
